Oil Major (BP/Gimmal)

The consultant served as a Project Manager on a project supporting and enhancing a system built from scratch to enable forensic accounting and legal document and information management related to a 2010 incident with very significant financial, environmental, and regulatory consequences. Duties included customer interface, productivity assurance, onshore and offshore personnel management, content type and metadata design, inter-team interface, and agile project development.

While engaged the Consultant was promoted twice by the client and both the consultant and his team members received performance-related awards.

Multinational Chemical Manufacturer (Chemtura/Gimmal)

The consultant served as a senior analyst on a multifaceted design project, leading the creation of the folder hierarchy, metadata design, and security schema for the largest group yet handled by the design team (Finance). Ninety interviews were conducted with thirty representatives of a 400-person department; legacy storage systems were examined, and educational sessions held to help the design team understand the important differences between an electronic content management system and a shared drive. A collection of deliverables was produced of sufficient completeness to go directly to the implementation team.

World's Largest Subsea Driller (Transocean/Gimmal)

The consultant served as a Senior Analyst on four projects. On the first, he designed and developed a hierarchical taxonomy covering the enterprise, departmental, and sub-departmental levels. The second project created a plan for a three-year, \$4MM (services and software) enterprise content and records management (ECRM) systems implementation project. A 14-document deliverable package covering forty-five projects was created in less than two months. This plan, with modifications for budgetary reasons, was accepted by the customer and is being implemented.

The third project drew on the first two: a continuation of the taxonomy development for the largest department, plus the design and implementation of document imaging for the three most important document classes. The fourth project completed the development and implementation of an enterprise-wide taxonomy in SharePoint.

Multinational Gases Manufacturer (Air Products/Gimmal)

The consultant served as a Senior Analyst, leading a Physical Records Management assessment, and completing the deliverables on time and budget. The consultant was then asked to participate in the development of ECRM Strategy deliverables as well.

Major Electricity Retailer (Reliant Energy)

The consultant served as a Senior Analyst within marketing operations. The consultant led a multidisciplinary team on a 9-month project to resolve an inappropriate bill calculation formula. On this project, the consultant modeled billing issues covering 150,000 customers, worked with IT to build, test, and implement new code, helped craft internal and external change communications, and trained call center employees. Customer losses due to this issue were limited to a fraction of one percent.

The consultant also led other customer-service improvement initiatives, served as liaison between Marketing, Sales, and Customer service on four campaigns per year, created ad hoc databases in MS Access still in use today, and configured data mining tools against an SAP system.
